UC BRAID Consortium Receives \$12M to Improve Heart, Lung Health

The UC CAI, a consortium of the five UC medical campuses – Davis, Irvine, Los Angeles, San Diego and San Francisco – has been awarded a \$12 million grant and designated by the National Institutes of Health (NIH) as one of three Centers for Accelerated Innovations by the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute (NHLBI) to translate leading-edge discoveries into innovative products that benefit patients. UC BRAID will oversee this effort.

CTSI-Supported Study: Higher Calorie Diets Shorten Stays for Teens with Anorexia

For adolescents hospitalized with anorexia nervosa, higher calorie diets produce twice the rate of weight gain compared to the lower calorie diets that currently are recommended. Since 2008, the UCSF Adolescent Eating Disorders Program has been starting patients on



a higher calorie approach in response to this emerging research from <u>Andrea Garber</u>, PhD, and her colleagues supported by CTSI's <u>Pediatric Clinical</u> <u>Research Center</u>.
